LCDS will provide all students with a complimentary “Agenda,” the official LCDS assignment book. Students are required to bring their Agenda to every class and to record homework assignments and due dates in it. If lost, students must ask for a replacement and will be charged \$5.00.

**Technology:** All students must bring a laptop, MacBook or Chromebook with their name on it, along with an accompanying sleeve or slim carrying case, also with their name on a label. LCDS staff will install all required software and shortcuts during the annual ‘Device Set-Up Days’ in August.

**Required Supplies for home:**

- a printer, printer paper, and replacement ink to print homework and weekend work as assigned.
- 3-hole punch
- Scissors, glue sticks, scotch tape

**Required supplies for all students:**

- Soft pencil bag with several #2 pencils, blue (or black) pens, red pens, and highlighters
- 12-inch ruler
- 4-pack of colored fine point dry erase markers
- 12-pack of colored pencils
- 2 sets of index cards, with a box or ring to hold one set, kept in the locker
- Several packs of looseleaf paper, kept at home and in the locker, to fill binders as needed
- 3-ring GREEN 1” binder labeled with student’s name and “English” on the cover, with 5 dividers inside labeled “General Info”, “Grammar”, “Vocabulary”, “Reading”, “Writing”
- 2-pocket GREEN folder labeled with student’s name and “English” on the cover
- 3-ring WHITE 1” binder labeled with student’s name and “Science” on the cover, with eight *pocket* dividers
- 3-ring BLACK 1” binder labeled with student’s name and “Social Studies” on the cover, with six dividers.
- 2-pocket BLACK folder labeled with the student’s name and “Social Studies Tests”
- 3-ring RED 1” binder labeled with student’s name and “Math” on the cover and 5 tab dividers
- 3-subject RED wide-ruled and perforated spiral notebook labeled with student’s name and “Math” on the cover
- Audio headsets/earbuds that connect to student laptop (either with a cord or wirelessly) in a sealed bag labeled with the student’s name
- Texas Instruments TI-30Xa calculator
- Music instrument and case with a luggage tag with the student’s name and grade attached to the outside of the case, and a music stand to be kept at home
