LCDS will provide all students with a complimentary “Agenda,” the official LCDS assignment book. Students are required to bring their Agenda to every class and to record homework assignments and due dates in it. If lost, students must ask for a replacement and will be charged \$5.00.

Technology: All students must bring a laptop, MacBook or Chromebook with their name on it, along with an accompanying sleeve or slim carrying case, also with their name on a label. LCDS staff will install all required software and shortcuts during the annual ‘Device Set-Up Days’ in August.

Required Supplies for home:

- a printer, printer paper, and replacement ink to print homework and weekend work as assigned.
- 3-hole punch
- Scissors, glue sticks, scotch tape

Required supplies for all students:

- Soft pencil bag with several #2 pencils, blue (or black) pens, red pens, and highlighters
- 12-inch ruler
- 1 11x16” dry erase board - possibly to be provided by LCDS
- 4-pack of colored fine point dry erase markers
- 12-pack of colored pencils
- Pack of colored fine-point markers
- 2 sets of index cards, with a box to hold them
- 3-ring GREEN 1” binder labeled with the student’s name and “English” on the cover, with five dividers inside labeled “General Info”, “Grammar”, “Vocabulary”, “Reading”, “Writing”
- 3-ring WHITE 1” binder labeled with student’s name and “Science” on the cover
- 2-pocket BLACK folder labeled with student’s name and “Civics” on the cover
- Audio headsets/earbuds that connect to student laptop (either with a cord or wirelessly) in a sealed bag labeled with the student’s name
- Music instrument and case with a luggage tag with the student’s name and grade attached to the outside of the case, and a music stand to be kept at home
- Specific attire for PE according to the sport selected. The link to the PE supply list can be found at the LCDS website.

MATH

Pre-Algebra Students

- 3-ring RED 1” binder labeled with the student’s name and “PreAlgebra” on the cover, with three dividers inside labeled “Notes”, “Worksheets”, “Quizzes”
- Texas Instruments TI-30Xa calculator

Algebra and Geometry Students

- 3-ring RED 1” binder labeled with the student’s name and “Algebra” or “Geometry” on the cover, with five dividers

- 3-subject wide-ruled RED spiral notebook labeled with the student's name and "Algebra" or "Geometry" on the cover
- TI-84 Calculator

WORLD LANGUAGE

French and Spanish Students

- 3-ring BLUE 1" binder labeled with the student's name and either "French" or "Spanish" on the cover and filled with loose leaf paper

RESOURCE

- Accordion folder that holds a minimum of 5 subjects

ART

- One pack of sponges or a bottle of dish soap

MUSIC

Band Students

- *Essential Techniques 2000*, Book 3, available through JWPepper.com. Returning students should already own this.
- Music stand for home.
- Brass players -- valve oil and slide grease
- Woodwind players -- cork grease and one box of extra reeds
- Percussionists -- snare drum, a set of orchestral bells, light snare sticks, and hard, small bell mallets

Orchestra Students

- *Strings Basics: Steps to Success for String Orchestra*, Book 3 (Terry Shade & Jeremy Woolstenhulme, published by Neil A. Kjos Music). Available through www.JWPepper.com. Returning students should already own this.
- Cleaning rag
- Music stand for home.
- Violin/viola players – shoulder rest, spare set of strings to be kept in the case, and "dampit" humidifier for winter months
- Bass - The student must have a bass instrument, but LCDS will provide the instrument used during class, so the student may keep his/hers at home
