This is a part-time and benefits eligible position. The individual hired will work four full days per week (preferably Monday to Thursday, but the four specific days are negotiable). They will also attend teacher workdays and meetings, and assume various duties commensurate with those of other LCDS specialty area teachers.

The responsibilities of the position include identifying and supporting students with mild learning disabilities and those struggling with the academic demands of the program, as well as supporting teachers in designing and delivering enrichment programs to academically gifted students. These could include pull-out or push-in programs, or simply being a resource for teachers.

The ideal candidate will have:

- Bachelor's degree is required (advanced degree is preferred), preferably in Education
- Multiple years of experience teaching students in the 8 to 11 age range
- Ability to connect and build positive relationships with children
- Ability to work collaboratively as a member of a team
- Growth mindset and willingness to seek professional development opportunities
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Comfort level using technology and incorporating it into teaching
